PARISH LITURGIES AT THE MOMENT

Sunday Masses:

Vigil Masses (Sat) 6.15pm & 8pm

Sunday: 10.30am, 12.30pm & 5.30pm

Weekday Masses:

10.30am Monday – Saturday; 7.30pm Tuesdays & Thursdays.

(This schedule will be reviewed again at the end of September)

Given that the Sunday obligation remains suspended, you may wish to consider attending a weekday Mass in place of Sunday. Those most at risk are asked to consider not coming to Mass at the moment.

We continue to observe the 2-metre rule & as such the number of persons admitted to the church is limited.

Please note that only people from the same household (those living under the same roof) may sit together. All others must sit at least 6 ft (2m) from each other.

BAPTISMS: Attendance is limited to the parents, godparents, grandparents (& any siblings of the child). Baptism forms are available on the parish website & should be returned to the parish office 2 weeks before the intended date. As of Sunday 6th September, Baptisms will be celebrated at 2.00 pm on a Sunday (those already booked will be honoured at the time booked).

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Every Saturday 11am - 12noon.

In addition:

Admission to the church will be by the front door only & exit via the side door only.

- Parishioners are asked to use the sanitizer provided.
- Admission to Holy Communion will be on row-by-row basis.
- Collection baskets will remain in a fixed place near the doors
- The parish bulletin will be available only as people leave the church.

Please note that all of the above remains under review and dependant on Government / Health Authority advice

HOSPITAL VISITATION: All visiting across all Southern Trust hospitals and sites has been suspended for the time being. The Trust is encouraging virtual visits, e.g. through smartphones, tablets, etc. Those who might need help setting this up can contact the Virtual Visiting Co-ordinator on 07776516419, from 9am – 5pm daily. Emergency, on-call chaplaincy cover remains in place.

CHURCH SANITISING: The parish wishes to thank the many volunteers who have helped with the sanitisation of the church over the past two months. While the assistance of so many people is very much valued, for the purposes of social distancing and contact tracing, we will be returning to a rota system. To help with the preparation of a rota, anyone who can assist (and who has not done so already) is asked to leave their contact and availability details in the Sacristy. **Thank you, once again, to all those involved.**

ROSARY / EVENING PRAYER: The Rosary continues to be broadcast via our webcam Monday – Friday at 7pm. Evening Prayer is broadcast each Sunday at 7pm.
